Sakai announced today the current status of its facilities and operations following its previous announcement released on March 18, 2011.

1. Status of area facilities and the recovery schedule

Onahama Manufacturing Site, Yumoto Works and Otsurugi Works, all located at Iwaki City, are being restored of their buildings and equipments after the inspection. Operations which need the industrial water supply are planed to resume from mid April, and those which do not need are planed to resume from early April, both with limited scale.

After the inspection and restorations of warehouses along with the recovery of road systems, Sakai has started shipping a part of products manufactured before the Earthquake.
